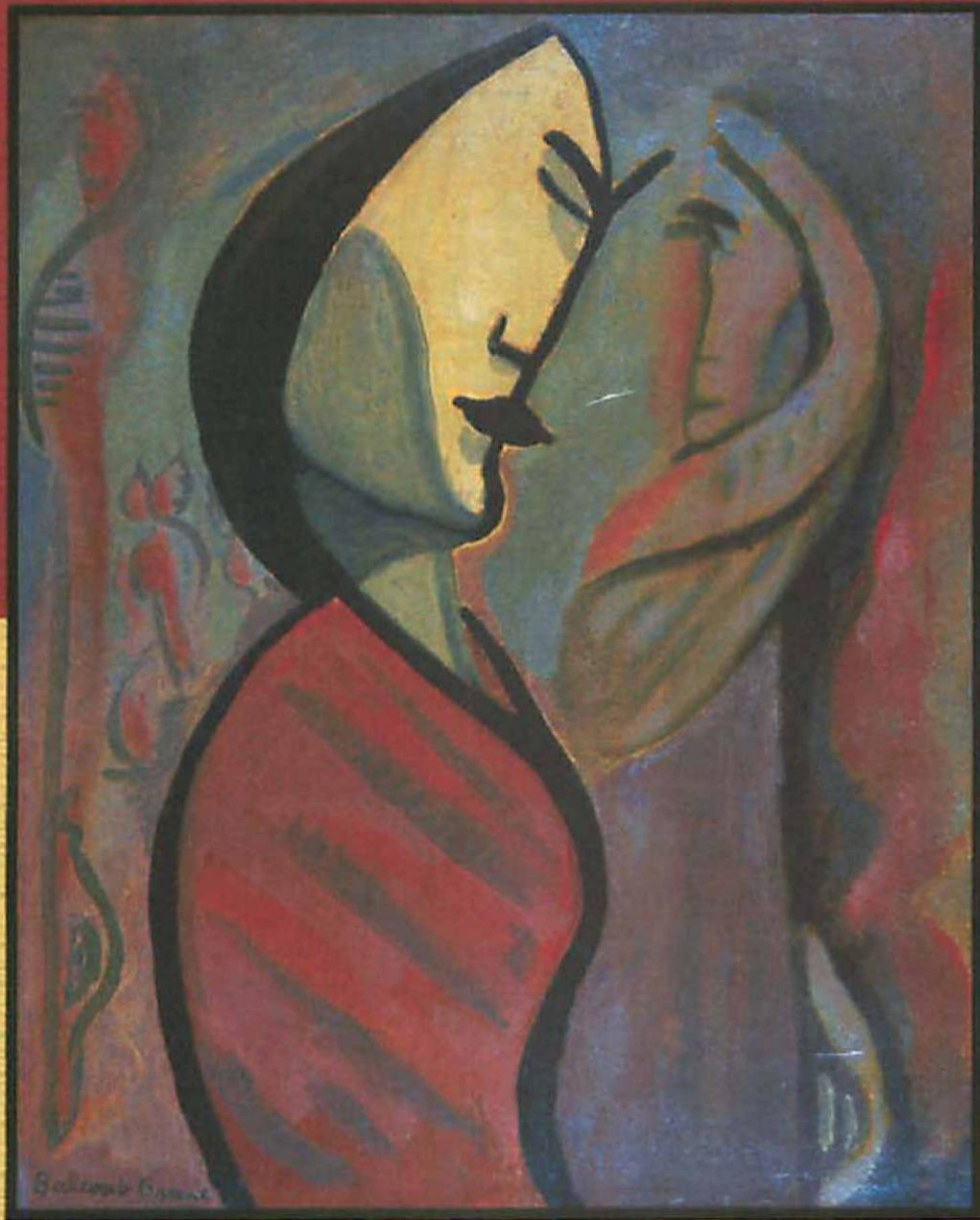

## **Focus on Facial Volume at Plastic Surgery Seminar**

### ***Beverly Hills Facial Plastic Surgeon, Dr. William J. Binder among Master Surgeons Teaching Techniques for Facial Rejuvenation***

San Diego, CA. January 18 - 22, 2012. Entitled "Rejuvenation of the Aging Face", the Educational and Research Foundation for the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery (AAFPRS) held a 5-day medical education meeting focused on "the volumetric nature of the aging face" and "the three-dimensional approach to facial rejuvenation". Among the world renowned surgeons who came to share their approaches and techniques for restoring youthful beauty to the face was **Dr. William J. Binder**, who discussed his *multi-level* approach to facial rejuvenation and his popular *Vertical Mid-Face Lift* with groups of practicing physicians. A longtime proponent of the 3-D approach for balancing facial proportions, Dr. Binder also led panel discussions and workshops on the critical issue of *Volume Restoration* beginning with the patient consultation and the various surgical procedures that follow. He also conducted a master dissection laboratory demonstrating his pioneering techniques utilizing custom facial implants to replace volume and lift sagging facial tissue resulting from the aging process.
